## Clues to find the name of Apostle

1. The building with the clock, next to Thirsk Hall Is where you'll find the man who started it all.

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2. Paintings and pottery on display, with a museum across the way.

3. Next door is a Chinese Take Away, there's a rainbow above and it starts with 'K'.

4. In Kirkgate, where Mum buys her meat to make you tasty things to eat.

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5. Liquorice, toffees and sugary things. What a lot of pleasure this tiny shop brings.

6. When buying fruit, it's a good place to stop it's very small – so it's an 'outside shop'.

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7. A café next to a pizza place and, in between, outside seating place.

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8. This flower shop has a card shop next door and, over the road, there are paints and more.

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9. For buying books it's a good place to shop look up –there's the Yorkshire flower on top.

10. Jigsaws, toys, newspapers too, this shop sells them all and it's your next clue.

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11. Next to a church, they sell beef and pork and chicken, just ready for your fork.

12. A café above and a shop down below – For interesting food it's a good place to go.

13. Knitting wool and things for sewing? Near the Police is where you should be going.
